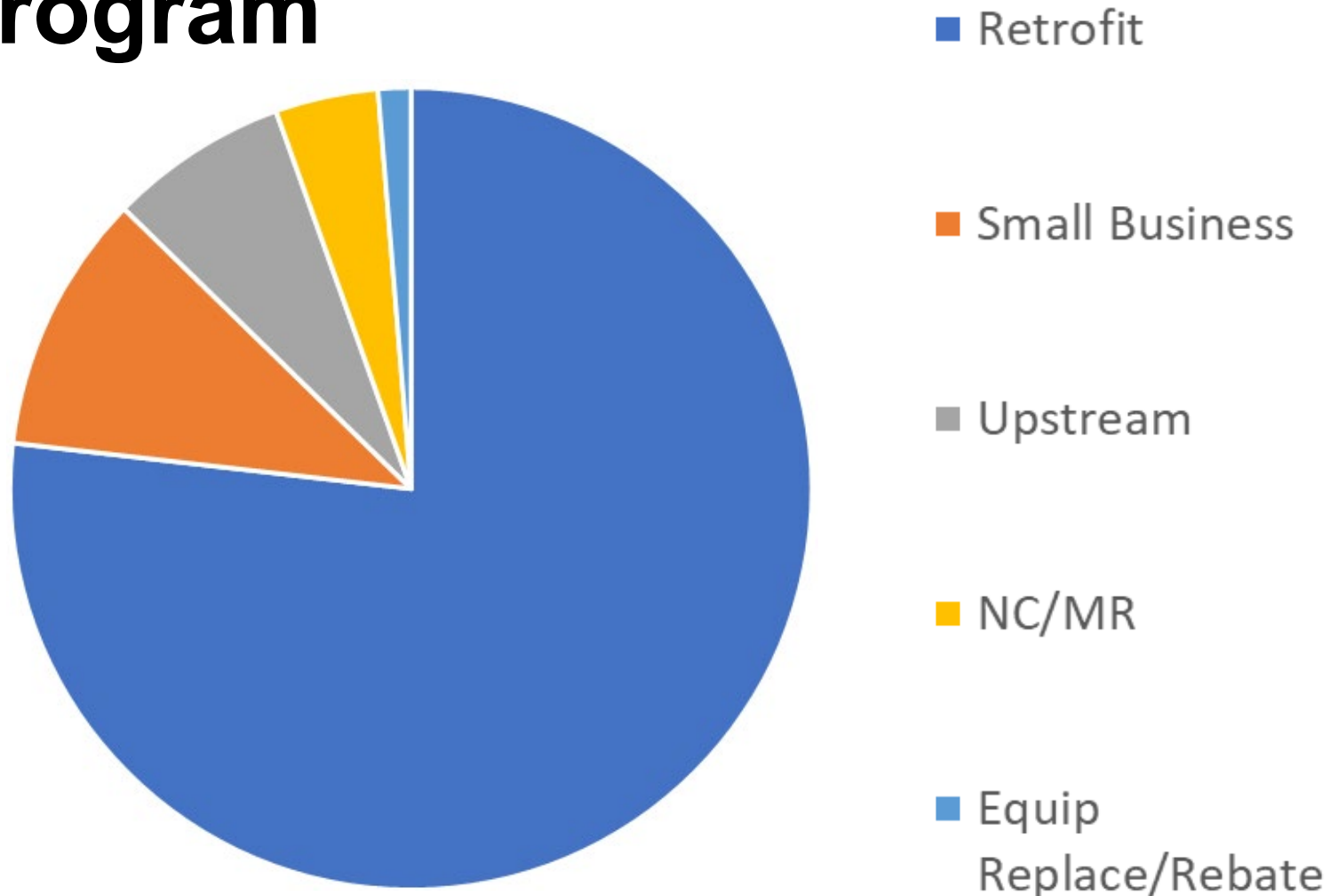

Step 1: Bring Us ALL these projects

New Buildings

- Schools
- Libraries
- Town Halls
- Pump Stations/WWTPs

New Equipment

- Nat Gas Boilers
- Rooftop Units
- Mini-splits
- Chillers

Step 2: Get cracking on Electric Savings

- LED lighting in 2019
 - LED lighting in 2020
 - LED lighting in 2021
- Fan and Pumping controls
- Street lights

Step 3: Do more with Natural Gas Savings

- Demand Control Ventilation
- Steam traps/pipe insulation
- Faucet aerators
- Hot water recirculator pump scheduling

Step 4: Combine Projects for Higher Incentives

- Address multiple end-uses
- Reduce internal transaction costs
- Combine fast and slow payback items to balance overall payback

Step 5: If all else fails, ask for help!

- Benchmarking
 - Electronic transfer of data into EPA Portfolio Manager
- Building audits
 - ASHRAE Level I or Level II audits
